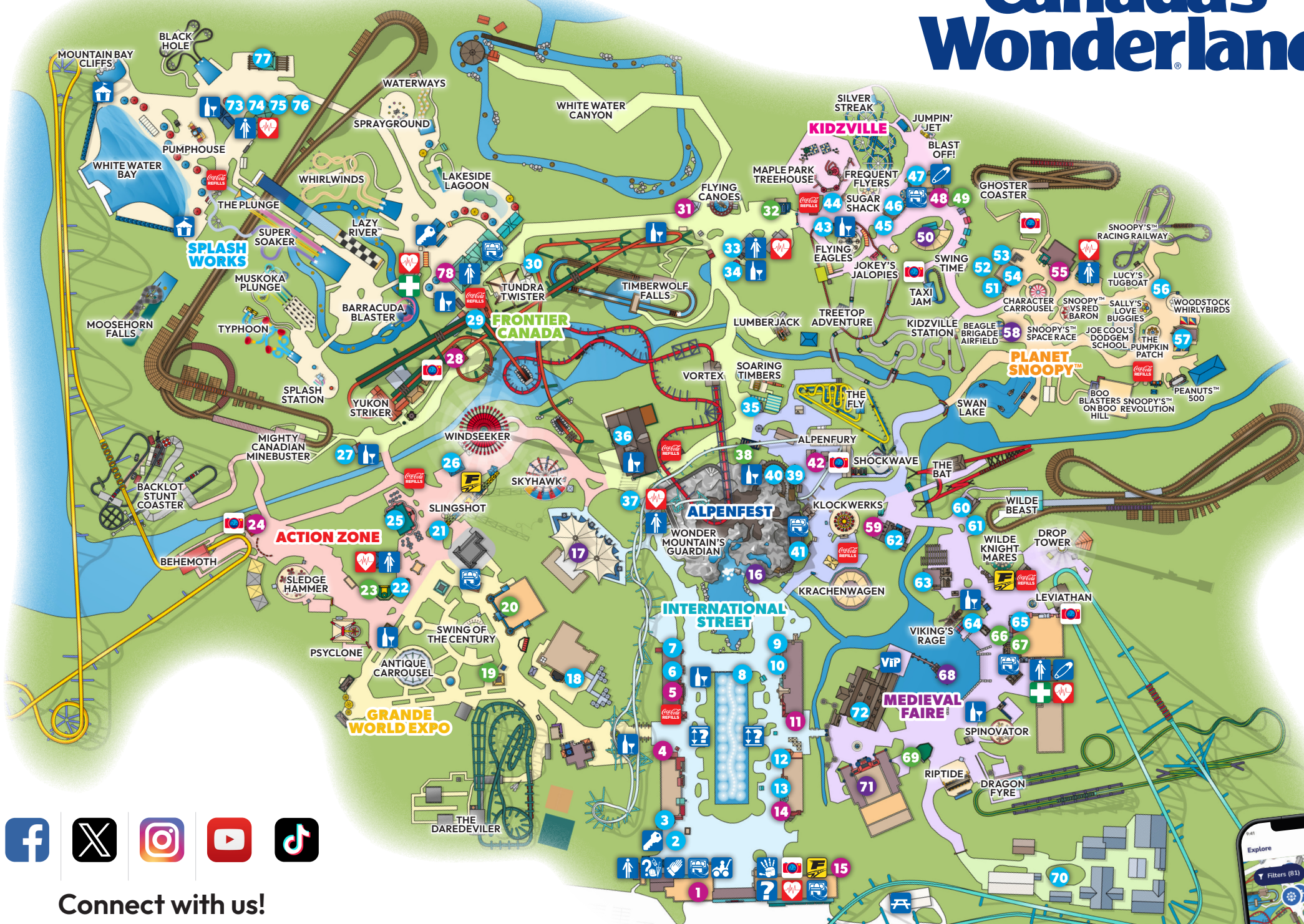

RIDER SAFETY

WARNING Many rides at Canada's Wonderland are dynamic and thrilling. There are inherent risks in riding any amusement ride. For your protection, each ride is rated for its special features, such as high speed, steep drops, sharp turns, or other dynamic forces. If you choose to ride, you accept all of these risks. Restrictions for guests of larger sizes (height or weight) are posted at certain rides. Guests with disabilities should refer to our Attraction Accessibility Program available at Guest Services. Participate responsibly. You should be in good health to ride safely. You know your physical conditions and limitations, Canada's Wonderland does not. If you suspect your health could be at risk for any reasons, or you could aggravate a pre-existing condition of any kind, **do not ride!**

RIDE SAFELY The Ontario Technical Standards and Safety Authority Act, 2000, Amusement Devices Regulation (O. Reg. #221/01), requires that riders obey all warnings and directions regarding any ride and behave in a manner that will not cause or contribute to injury to themselves or others. You can be charged under the Act if you fail to follow the rules for riding safely.

FOR YOUR SAFETY All restraint systems, including lap bars, shoulder harnesses, and seatbelts, must be positioned, fastened, and tightened properly to allow guests to ride. Guests with a history of recent surgery, heart trouble, high blood pressure, neck trouble, back trouble, or who are pregnant should carefully heed all warning signs at each ride entrance. Generally, Guests must have the ability to brace themselves upright in the seat and support their head and neck during the ride movements.

The safety of our Guests and associates is our number one priority at Canada's Wonderland. Safety is a shared partnership between the park and our guests. Height requirements and any special instructions regarding the ride are posted at the entrance of every ride. Guests are asked to follow all posted and verbal instructions and carefully consider the ride requirements and use good judgment before, during and after their ride.

Canada's Wonderland has the right to make the final decision regarding eligibility of a rider based on a person's size, weight, or other physical or mental limitations; provided the Guest has properly disclosed any physical or mental impairment(s).

Any Guest who would like more information on any ride is encouraged to visit Guest Services to obtain a Guest Assistance Guide.

LOOSE ARTICLES Most rides cannot accommodate loose articles including cell phones, hats, cameras, purses, backpacks, umbrellas, beverage containers, electronic devices, etc. Smaller items must be safely secured in cargo pockets, a waist pack, in a bin on the ride platform, in a locker, or with a non-rider. Canada's Wonderland is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged items.

Due to the nature of rides, items that do not fit in a cargo pocket or waist pack that securely closes will not be permitted. Waist packs must be able to be lifted over a tightened seatbelt or lap bar and may not interfere with the proper function of the restraint system or proper riding position with back and shoulders against the seat back. Your hands must be free to hold on while riding, therefore nothing can be held in your hands. All food and drink must be finished prior to boarding any ride or entering any ride station. If you lose an item, notify a ride operator for assistance. For your safety, do not enter fenced areas. Entering a fenced area may result in serious injury.

Any guest who intentionally disables a safety restraint, breaks a ride admission policy, or whose actions endanger themselves or others will be required to leave the park.

All Guests must adhere to the park's loose article policy. Any non-compliance which results in damage or injury to person or property will result in consequences up to and including prosecution.

Based on rider height, some rides may require a Guest to be accompanied by a **SUPERVISING COMPANION** to ride. A Supervising Companion is at least 54" in height and approximately 14 years of age, who meets all other criteria for riding, and who will assist their Companion in complying with safe participation instructions. Supervising Companions are responsible for ensuring that the accompanied Rider remains seated properly where applicable and follows all rules and regulations. The Supervising Companion must be seated in the same seat (row) as the Rider who needs accompaniment and can accompany the number of Riders for which the seat is designed. For example, if a seat is designed for three people, the Supervising Companion can accompany two riders.

HAND-HELD INFANTS/SMALL CHILDREN are not permitted on most rides. A hand-held infant is a child who is unable to walk to the ride unit independently or maintain independent seated postural control during ride.

Failure to abide by all park rules can result in ejection from the park without refund and/or arrest/legal prosecution as dictated by law.

PARK INFORMATION

Smoking For the convenience of all Guests, smoking of any kind, including vapor and e-cigarettes, is not permitted inside the park. Thank you for your cooperation.

Accessibility Guests with disabilities should visit Guest Services to download or pick up a copy of the Guest Assistance Guide. This guide explains the entry guidelines and procedures and provides specific riding criteria related to each attraction. Guests who are seeking accommodations may visit Guest Services for assistance. Please note, a form may be required for specific mobility issues. Braille and large print guidebooks with park information are available at Guest Services.

Cash-to-Card Kiosk At Canada's Wonderland, we are cashless throughout the park. Simply swipe or tap your credit card, debit card, or smart device with ApplePay or Google Pay where you would normally use cash. It's faster, safer, and always secure. No card? No problem! At our Cash-to-Card Kiosks, you can convert Canadian bills into a prepaid credit card you can use anywhere across Canada — not just inside the park. It's easy and FREE!

Credit Cards Canada's Wonderland accepts MasterCard, American Express, VISA, and Interac Direct Payment for admission and purchases.

Dress Code Shirts and shoes must be worn in the park at all times, including entering or exiting. Appropriate swimwear required. Thongs and transparent clothing are not permitted. Clothing with profanity, obscene gestures or statements, and costumes or disguises to conceal identity are all prohibited in the park.

First Aid/Security The First Aid Centre, located in Medieval Faire, is staffed with trained personnel to assist with your medical needs. For immediate assistance, speak with the nearest park associate to have First Aid team members come to your location.

Food and Drink Picnic baskets and coolers are welcome at the shelter located outside Canada's Wonderland on the north side of our Front Gate. Outside food and beverages are not allowed in the Park. Bottled water, baby food, and formula may be brought into the park.

Guest Services Guest Services can help you with anything from general inquiries to finding out what time your favourite show starts. It also serves as a message centre and lost children's area. Canada's Wonderland does not offer personalized public paging.

Inclement Weather Policy Closed rides and attractions will be reopened as soon as possible.

KidTrack Wristbands are available at the Height Check stations. Write your cell phone number on your child's wristband and, if needed, the associate who finds your child will activate the KidTrack system.

Line Jumping Policy To ensure that all Guests have a fair opportunity to enjoy a ride as quickly as possible, line jumping is not allowed at Canada's Wonderland. Line jumping, regardless of the reason, may lead to ejection from the Park. **NO REFUND WILL BE GIVEN.** Line jumping is defined as: 1. Cutting in front of Guests who are already in line; or 2. Saving a place for someone; or 3. Leaving a line, then attempting to re-enter at the same point. Since this includes using the restroom or purchasing food or drink, we suggest you make all stops prior to entering a line.

Loose Articles on Ride Please take care to secure all loose items before riding. Guests must accept risk for any unsecured items, as well as items left or placed on the platform. **For your safety, do not enter unauthorized areas to retrieve lost articles.** You may be seriously injured if you enter an unauthorized area. Please report lost articles to a ride associate or at Lost and Found.

Rider Swap This program is intended to help Guests with small children, service animals, and valuable items that cannot be left alone. One Guest waits in line and both get to ride separately. To participate in Rider Swap, please see a ride associate for more details. Rider Swap is not available in Splash Works.

Same Day Re-Entry Photos will be taken for all ticket and Season Passholders upon entry. A valid ticket/season pass and photo is required for re-entry to the park. Please note there is no re-entry to the parking lot.

Stroller, Locker & Wheelchair Rentals Stroller, locker, and wheelchair rentals are available inside the park at the Front Gate, beside Canada's Wonderland Store. They are on a first-come, first-served basis. Additional lockers are available at Splash Works.
